Eligibility for Participation:

Any Northampton Township resident who is scheduled to graduate from any accredited High School during the current academic year (usually May or June) is eligible to submit an application for the Scholarship provide they meet ALL of the requirements of the Program:

1. Applicant must be a legal resident of Northampton Township, Bucks County, PA at the time that application is submitted and at the time that applicant graduates from high school.
2. Applicant must be planning to attend a post-high school educational program at an accredited school or facility (academic, technical, trade) in the academic year immediately following High School graduation.
3. Applicant must submit an essay as outlined below.

Application Process - Submission, Rules, Judging Criteria:

Eligible High School Students must adhere to the rules outlined. Any Applicant whose submission does not conform to ALL requirements will be disqualified.

1. Eligible Applicants may obtain their Application Materials from their High School Guidance Office, the Northampton Township Republican Committee or the Committee's website (www.northamptongop.org), or any other source provided that they use the official materials for the current Academic Year.
2. The APPLICATION FORM must be filled completely and ALL requested information provided. All instructions must be followed.
3. Specific Essay Assignment:
 - a. The assignment (question, topic, etc.) is contained at the TOP of this Page 2.
 - b. All essays must be a minimum of 650 words but should not exceed 800 words. Finished essays must be "typed" using Calibri, Arial, Arial Narrow, or Times Roman 12pt font double spaced.
 - c. All essays must address the topic fully. Typically, a topic will ask for an understanding of a concept and/or require the Applicant to take a position and defend their stance.
 - d. Plagiarism is not tolerated and any evidence of plagiarism shall immediately disqualify the Applicant from award.
4. Criteria for Judging:
 - a. All materials must be submitted as requested, in the form and format indicated, and **received on or before the April 15th Deadline.**
 - b. Content of the Essay will be judged as follows:
 - 40% - Basis of Argument - Evidence of critical thinking and logical conclusions
 - 40% - Knowledge of Topic - Evidence of research, exploratory investigation
 - 20% - Grammar, prose and writing style.
 - c. Decisions of the Judges are final.
5. Submitting your Application & Essay:
 - a. The Applications and Contest Materials shall be submitted in an anonymous interior envelope Marked "NTRC Excellence In Government & Citizenship Application". There shall be no identifying marks or other indications as to the identity of the Applicant on this interior envelope or on any contents of the envelope.
 - b. The Applicant shall complete all information on the Applicant Form. THE APPLICANT FORM IS NOT TO BE SEALED IN THE INTERIOR ENVELOPE! The interior envelope is to be sealed and placed into an exterior envelope along with the APPLICANT FORM and mailed to the address shown on the top of PAGE 1.

Award(s) & Recognition

By May 7th, the Scholarship Committee will complete its judging. The following Schedule approximates dates for finalization of award(s):

May 9th - Notification via email and letter to Winner(s) and their respective School

May 11th - Verification by School of Winner(s)' expected graduation

May 16th - Confirmation of Award(s) and date of School Presentation (if any)

May 23th - Press Release announcing Winner(s)
